RESERVED DEFENCE SEATS IN MEDICAL/DENTAL COLLEGES
AS GOVERNMENT OF INDIA NOMINEE UNDER
MINISTRY OF DEFENCE QUOTA(2018-19)

1. **Applications are invited for Allocation of central pool MBBS/BDS Seats as Government of India nominee under Ministry of Defence quota for academic year 2018-19 {subject to allotment of seats by Ministry of Health}, from wards/widows/wives of Armed Forces Personnel. Applicants may apply as per priorities shown below:-**

- Priority I : Widows/Wards of Defence personnel killed in action.
Priority II : Wards of disabled in action and **boarded out** from service.
Priority III : Widows/Wards of Defence personnel who died while in service with death attributable to military service.
- Priority IV : Wards of disabled in service and **boarded out** with disability attributable to military service.
Priority V : Wards of Ex-Servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards:
i. Param Vir Chakra
ii. Ashok Chakra
iii. Maha Vir Chakra
iv. Kirti Chakra
v. Vir Chakra
vi. Shaurya Chakra
vii. Sena , Nau Sena, Vayu Sena Medal
viii. Mention-in-Dispatches.
- Priority VI : Wards of Ex-Servicemen
Priority VII : Wives of:
i) Defence personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service.
ii) Defence personnel disabled in action and boarded out with disability attributable to military service.
iii) Ex-servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards.
- Priority VIII : Wards of Serving Personnel.
Priority IX : Wives of Serving Personnel.

2. **Eligibility for Candidature**

- (a) Scheme is open to Indian National only.
(b) Wards of Civilians are not eligible.
(c) Selection of candidates for reserved seats as Govt of India Nominee will be made on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in NEET-2018 conducted by CBSE. Candidates who do not qualify the NEET should not apply.

3. Candidates are required to apply online on KSB Sectt website **www.ksb.gov.in** after declaration of NEET Result. The last date of submitting online application is **30th June 2018**. Eligibility certificate to be completed and signed by RSB/ZSB and countersigned by OIC Records and for serving personnel in priority V, VII, VIII (iii) & IX can also be signed by CO/OC Unit to be uploaded alongwith supporting documents and photograph of candidates.
